## An Coláiste / The College

Since 2004 Coláiste Laighean has run Irish summer courses at Good Counsel College, New Ross Co Wexford. As a privately run Irish College 'Coláiste Laighean' offers Junior & Senior courses with classes directed towards preparation for state exams. Good Counsel College's private campus, located just outside New Ross town, offers a unique opportunity to create a Gaeltacht atmosphere and provides a true learning experience for all students in the Sunny South East. The campus provides an excellent learning environment, offering a wide range of educational, sporting and social activities, boarding accommodation and a modern restaurant.

### CÚRSA 'A' (Pre-Leaving Cert) (Higher Level only)

**Day 1 Irish Oral and Aural (300 marks).** Our experienced teachers, who are Dept of Education Examiners, will offer clear instruction on best practice and study techniques to allow students to prepare for the Irish Oral and Aural with confidence.

**Day 2 Paper 1 & 2 (300 marks)** The Course will include instruction on the Aiste, Léamhthuiscint, Prós, Filíocht and Gramadach. Students will receive instruction in the morning and afternoon, and will be given excellent notes that will be of great benefit to them while preparing for their final exams.

### CÚRSA 'B' (Pre-Junior Cert)

This is an intensive one day revision course covering all aspects of the Junior Cycle Irish exam. Course B is designed for Higher level students.

### CÚRSA 'C', 'D', 'E' & 'F' (Summer Courses)

The teachers and instructors on the course are very experienced, fully fluent in Gaelige and have been part of other coláistí samhraidh for many years. The teachers bring with them a range of different ideas and teaching methods to ensure that your sons and daughters gain a positive and progressive learning experience.

### Feighlíocht / Supervision

It is our primary aim to look after each and every student on the course and to ensure that they are fully supervised at all times. No risks will be taken in this area and should a child put himself or others in any danger, he or she will be removed from the course immediately. There will be a teacher assigned to each house and will be on call at all times throughout the night should he or she be needed. In addition, there will be a Cinnire (Senior Pupil) assigned to each house to attend to the pupils and to encourage them to speak Irish at all times. C.C.T.V. is in operation 24 hours a day to help ensure the safety and security of our students while on the campus. All our teachers and supervisors are Garda vetted.



## CLÁR AN LAE (DAILY PROGRAMME)

### Ranganna / Classes (10.00am - 1.00pm)

#### Rang 1

Bunstruchtúr na teanga In this class, the pupil will be taught the very basics of the Irish language, focusing particularly on Irish Grammar.

#### Rang 2

Rang Scrúdaithe In this class the pupil will focus entirely on exam preparation. Students will be given comprehensive notes to help them prepare for the State Exams. **Junior Cert students will be given guidance to help them to prepare for class CBAs**

#### Rang 3

In this class, students will develop their conversational and listening skills

### Imeachtaí Iárnóna / Afternoon Activities (2.00pm - 5.00pm)

Students will receive expert tuition on all aspects of the following sports/activities during the afternoon session: Cispheil, Sacar, Peil Ghaelach, Iomáint, Badmanton, Unihoc, Leadóg, Snámh, Astro Sacar, Giomnásiam, Dodgeball, Rounders, and Art & Crafts. Students will also have full use of Good Counsel's glass backed handball/racquetball court, indoor and outdoor basketball courts, tennis courts and astro turf pitches. Students will also have access to the new state of the art town leisure centre and swimming pool complex on our campus.

### Céilí (7.00pm - 10.00pm)

Always a highlight of the summer Gaeltacht experience, the céilí is a fun and informal social occasion. Students learn Irish dancing and music in a relaxed and fun atmosphere. Our Themed Nights include 'Black & White', 'Fancy Dress', 'Hawaii' Céilí and Talent Show.

### Turas Scoile / School Tour

As a break from routine, students are given the option of bowling, paintball, kayaking tours or surfing (Freedom Surf School). The Bowling tour is complementary, additional tours may incur an extra cost

### An Bhialann / The Restaurant

Our menus have been tried and tested by other camps at Good Counsel and provide a very balanced diet with sufficient calories for a week full of activity. Every attempt will be made to accommodate students with special dietary needs, however these should be specified on the application form.

### An Dochtúir / The Doctor

In the event of a pupil requiring medical attention Coláiste Laighean uses the services of Airmount Surgery and the Caredoc facility. A qualified First Aid attendant is on duty at all times. Parents/Guardians are responsible for payment of any medical fees incurred.



## Rialacha Ginearálta / General Rules

1. Pupils may not leave the campus for any reason whatsoever without the permission of the Coláiste Principal. Parents/guardians must sign their child out should they wish to bring him/her to a match or other activity and sign him/her in on return to the campus.
2. Mobile phones are collected at the start of each camp and are returned to the Students once every three days (7.30-7.45pm) to facilitate home contact. Further home contact can be facilitated through the Principal.
3. Bullying will not be tolerated at Coláiste Laighean, as per our anti-bullying and child protection policies.
4. Consumption/possession of cigarettes, alcohol or other drugs is prohibited.
5. Pupils must be in their assigned accommodation by 10:30pm and must remain there until 8:30am the following day.
6. Serious company-keeping is not allowed and it is left to the discretion of the Principal to deal with this sensibly in the best interests of the student, parent and college.

## Rial na Gaeilge / The Irish Rule

**As the purpose of the course is to develop the pupils' Irish language fluency, Coláiste Laighean has a strict but fair rule regarding communication:**

1. If a student speaks a complete sentence in English, he or she will receive a verbal warning.
2. If a student speaks a complete sentence in English for the second time, he or she will receive a further verbal warning.
3. If a student speaks a full sentence in English a third time, his or her parents are informed.
4. If a student speaks a full sentence in English a fourth time he or she will have to be removed from the course and picked up by his/her parents/guardians.

**Please note** it is not our intention to send anyone home. We hope that all pupils will enjoy the course and leave with a better standard of Irish. There will be classes on the first day to teach students the basics necessary to get by. However we will implement Rial na Gaeilge and those who are not committed to making an honest effort should not apply for the course. In the unlikely event that your child is removed from the Coláiste, fees are non-refundable.
